



5% TARIFFS ON MEXICAN GOODS STARTING JUNE 10TH --

TARIFFS TO INCREASE 5% EACH MONTH UNTIL RATE HITS 25%

Today, President Trump announced that starting on June 10, 2019, goods of Mexican origin will be subject to a 5% tariff. The [tweet](#) indicated that more details would be released tomorrow (Friday, May 31, 2019), but in a [statement](#) released by the White House, the White House indicated that the tariffs would increase to 10% on July 1st, 15% on August 1st, 20% on September 1st and 25% on October 1st where they will remain until Mexico takes unspecified steps to curb illegal immigration to the United States.

Pisani & Roll LLP will provide an additional updates as further details are released, but since the stated rationale of the tariffs is said to be to incentivize Mexico to further curb illegal immigration, it would appear that all goods, NAFTA eligible or not, that are of Mexican origin will be subject to the new tariffs.
