



USTR PUBLISHES 5th LIST OF PRODUCTS EXCLUDED FROM 25% LIST 1 CHINA TARIFFS

The USTR [released](#) a fifth set of exclusions for 89 products covered by the original "List 1" Section 301 tariffs on Chinese products. Previously, in December 2018, the USTR [published](#) a first list of products that would be excluded from List 1. A [second](#), [third](#), and [fourth](#) list of products were published on March 25, 2019, April 18, 2019, and May 14, 2019, respectively.

Today's publication represents a fifth tranche of exclusions regarding List 1. The 89 excluded products are found on pages 6-12 of the [release](#).

These 89 new exclusions are available for any importer, not only the importer who filed the exclusion request. They also will be available for one (1) year. As a result, any importer paying the 25% List 1 duty on Chinese origin products should review their imports against this list of product exclusions (and the prior 4 exclusion lists) to determine if they may benefit from any of these exclusions.
